"Bhateja" gotra is associated with both jatt and Arora-Khatri community, prominent group in Northern India. Historically, members of this community are considered Suryavanshi Kshatriyas, tracing their lineage back to Lord Rama. While the surname is most prevalent in India, particularly in the states of Maharashtra, Punjab, and Delhi, it is relatively rare globally. The Bhateja community has made significant contributions across various fields, including technology, medicine, finance, business, engineering, education, construction, recreation, and the armed forces. They are known for their strong adherence to traditions and values.
